

Ling Sound Test

The Ling sound test is used to check that an individual has access to sounds across the full speech spectrum.

Detection: The individual indicates a sound is heard

Identification: The individual repeats the sound or points to a card

Directions

- 1. Say each sound, one at a time, and in no particular order. Use a normal speaking volume. Remove all lipreading and visual cues.
- 2. Repeat this test with each processor (or hearing aid) alone.
- 3. Check distance hearing by delivering the sounds from 2-3 meters away.
- 4. Document the results.
- 5. Discuss any difficulties with your hearing professional.
